Scope and Importance of Award

The Alice Holloway Young Award for Distinguished Service by a Retired Trustee. It signifies outstanding dedicated service to a community college after the Trustee's retirement from the Board.

Criteria – Alice Holloway Young Award for Distinguished Service by a Retired Trustee

- How has the former trustee demonstrated ongoing advocacy for the mission of the community college during and *after* their formal service on the Board?
- How has the former trustee provided leadership in helping to solve challenges to two year post-secondary education?
- What has the retired trustee initiated and helped to develop in the area of innovative programs used in two year post-secondary institutions?
- How has the ongoing service of the former trustee offered opportunities to students, faculty, and/or staff at the local, regional, and/or statewide community colleges?

A maximum of three (3) Alice Holloway Young Awards will be presented in a given year
